Goal 1: Provide services to 1,000 targeted students	C	Student Services/Intake: 189 students received information regarding college attendance and provided intake services at The College Place by staff.
Goal 2: Provide counseling, career coaching, and academic planning.	C	Counseling and Career Services: 138 students completed a full regimen of counseling, career, and academic planning services.
Goal 3: Ensure students receive academic assessment plans and understand their interest areas and potential.	C	Assessments: 84 students participated in follow-up sessions at The College Place which included interest and career interest assessments and receiving information related to college enrollment and program options.
