



Directions for Submitting Projects

How to Submit Projects:

Step 1:

- Cities, counties and agencies should submit their project(s) to the email address associated with the applicable work group listed below no later than **5:00 pm, Wednesday, March 18, 2009**.
- All projects should be submitted using the appropriate Excel spreadsheet template available at www.sjvpartnership.org. All of the templates are identical, with the exception of transportation.

Note: On the Excel sheet, you must specify whether it is a Tier 1, Tier 2 or Tier 3 project (first column on the sheet). Tier 1 projects are for immediate funding (i.e. project can start within 180 days of June 1, 2009). They will be on a use-it-or-lose-it basis. In other words if you awarded the funding and cannot meet the deadlines for starting and completing the project you will lose the funding.

Tier 2 projects are projects that will start within two years of funding. See BTH Guidelines for examples of projects.

Tier 3 projects may include support for housing and communities impacted by mortgage and financial crises. See BTH Guidelines for examples of projects.

- Example of submittal process - transportation projects should be emailed in their Excel format to the Regional Policy Committee at sjvtransportationproject@gmail.com; economic development projects should be emailed to the Central California Economic Development Corporation at sjveconomicdevelopmentproject@gmail.com, etc.

Step 2: The work groups will review projects and verify based on a set criteria consistent to all projects in that work group. The work groups will forward their projects to the Secretariat of the California Partnership for the San Joaquin Valley no later than **5:00 pm, Friday, March 20, 2009**.

Step 3: The Secretariat will assemble the projects and complete the “draft” Regional Economic Recovery Work Plan to the Business, Transportation and Housing (BTH) Agency no later than **Wednesday, April 1, 2009**.

Step 4: The Plan will be available for regional review and approval in May.

Step 5: The final Plan will be submitted to BTH by **June 1, 2009**.
